After the track "What If" released last year, SANKT VELTEN present another song with the new line-up: Arnd (DARKNESS), Eldar "Piper" Ibrahimovic (War-Head, Definat) and Tom Becker (ex HOLY MOSES).

With the new song "Dies Irae" SANKT VELTEN sharpen their own profile. While the first album "The Discreet Charm of Evil" and the last single were still classified as speed and power metal, "Dies Irae" is much heavier and dispenses with choirs and orchestral parts. The song captivates with a driving, triplet beat and anticipates that the band will take a harder musical path in the new line-up than before.

"Dies Irae" (Day of Wrath) is originally a medieval Latin hymn that was used as part of the mass for the dead. The text describes the Last Day, when humanity will be judged before God. The original hymn is known for its dark and haunting language, which inspired SANKT VELTEN. As such, the song fits perfectly into the band's artistic concept of depicting things from the devil's perspective.

Like the previous releases, "Dies Irae" will be released on the label "Scare-Records" and will be available for download and streaming from February 21st. A video worth seeing was also shot for the song, which will be released simultaneously on the YouTube channel of the band and the label.
